His unique and varied life included serving as Chairs of Architectural Review Boards and Planning Commissions.

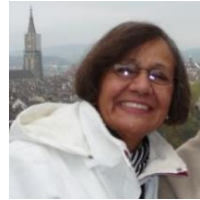
